

## How to Configure Laptop for Internet

- Switch-On your Wireless LAN Adapter by pressing wifi button, most Likely with the symbol  or .
- Search the available Wireless Networks.
- Find UMT-Wireless and Connect it.
- Configure the proxy setting of your Internet Browser.

### Internet Explorer



1. On the **Tools** menu in Internet Explorer, (Alt + t) click **Internet Options**, click the **Connections** tab, and then click **LAN Settings**.
2. Under **Proxy server**, click to select the **Use a proxy server for your LAN** check box.
3. In the **Address** box, type the IP address of the proxy server **172.2.0.40**.
4. In the **Port** box, type the port number **8080**.
5. Click to select the **Bypass proxy server for local addresses**.
6. Click **OK** to close the **LAN Settings** dialog box.
7. Click **OK** again to close the **Internet Options** dialog box.

**Note:** Configuration done for IE also works for Google Chrome Because it takes the Proxy Setting of IE.

### Mozilla Firefox



1. On the **Tools** menu in Mozilla Firefox, click **Options**.
2. Select the **Advanced** button.
3. Select the **Network** tab.
4. In the **Connection** section, click **Settings**.
5. Click on **Manual proxy configuration**:
  - a. In the **HTTP Proxy** box, type **172.2.0.40**.
  - b. In the **Port** box, type the port number **8080**.
  - c. Click on **Use this Proxy server for all protocols**.
6. Click **OK** to close the **Connection settings**. Use this Proxy server for all **Protocols**.
7. Click **OK** to close the **Options window**.

- Now, when you start for browsing, Browser prompts you for User name and Password .
- User Name: UMT\[your ID]. (e.g. “**umt\1234567890**”)
- Password: Enter your system log-in Password
