University of Management and Technology (UMT)

UMT is a project of Institute of Leadership and Management (ILM) Trust. UMT – now an independent, not-for-profit, private institution of higher learning – received her degree-granting charter first as the Institute of Management and Technology (IMT) in 2002 through an Act of the Assembly of the Punjab. Later, on 16 June 2004, IMT became University of Management and Technology through the passing of a similar Act by the Punjab Assembly.

In 2015, the University of Management and Technology (UMT) celebrated 25 years of 'Emergence with Eminence' in recognition of its contribution to the promotion of higher education in Pakistan. As a premier institution of higher learning in the country, UMT is recognized by the HEC of Pakistan as a 'W4 Category' (highest rank) university. For more than two years, UMT was also at the top as per HEC ranking in General Category (medium-sized) of private sector institutions in the Punjab. At present, 150+ accredited programs are being offered in the 13 Schools and 5 Institutes operating in the University.

Over the years, UMT has become renowned for its highly rated faculty members who are graduates from top universities of the world with vast experience of the corporate and business sector. With 450+ faculty members including 120+ PhDs and 20:1 student faculty ratio, UMT can rightly lay claim to being one of the few universities in the region that has the most highly qualified and experienced faculty members.

Facilities

Laboratories

UMT is equipped with 50+ science, engineering and textile laboratories to provide hands-on learning and practical experience to students. The learning is augmented through practical work done in these laboratories. The laboratories are regularly upgraded and expanded to provide a world-class learning experience to our students.

Library and Learning Resource Center

UMT supports its academic programs and research initiatives through a state-of-the-art Library and Learning Resource Center (L&LRC). The intrinsic focus of the L&LRC is to make available the

persistent intellectual linkage required to build specific resources, and pave the way towards attainment of rare tobe-found scripts, contents and substances for researchers and students. The wellstocked Library and Learning Resource Center has over 115,000 books to facilitate learning and research, 70 foreign and local journals, 15 online databases, 300,000 digital resources, 15 annually subscribed foreign journals, 7 special collections and 1 Learning Disability Center. ILM Fund



UMT Clinic

UMT Mosque and Islamic Center

The University of Management and Technology (UMT), Lahore, envisions a purpose-built campus that is complete in all dimensions of a modern university albeit with an Islamic perspective. The UMT Campus is a place of learning equipped with top-of-the-line learning facilities but first and foremost, it is envisaged as a place where students can worship, learn and strengthen their bonding with Allah for holistic and spiritual development. In these challenging times, when the Muslim *Ummah* is facing numerous cultural and intellectual challenges, the spiritual advancement of future generations of Muslims assumes even greater significance. The UMT Mosque and Community Center will serve just this purpose. Already, a *qari* has been appointed to teach *nazira* and *tajveed* to all those who seek spiritual fulfillment. Daily prayers, Friday and *Eid* prayers are also being offered in UMT mosque. Facilities for *itikaf* are also available in the UMT mosque.

The Mosque Project - the progress so far

Our mission is to design a mosque to serve as a center of spiritual, religious, educational, social and cultural learning for all the students/participants. Keeping this in view, the basic principles and prototypical standards set by our Prophet Muhammad (PBUH) for setting up a mosque have been observed. The UMT mosque, once completed, will present an architectural blend of old and contemporary Islamic art. Situated in the hub of UMT Campus, the Mosque has 70 feet multi-faceted circular folded dome rising 30 feet above the main prayer hall roof top guarded with two minarets standing tall at 100 feet; each opening up in a praying formation with reflection of 'Qalam' (pen) harmonizing with the learning environment of the University.

Completion of Phase 1


Already the physical structure of the two-storey purpose-built mosque has been laid out; thanks largely to the blessings of Allah, the proactive and determined efforts of the UMT community, and the generous donations offered by philanthropists and alumni. Projected cost of the entire project amounts to Rs 69.02 million out of which Rs 30 million has been raised and spent in completing the first phase of the construction.

Development and Enhancement - Phase II

The second phase of the project will culminate in completion and adornment of the existing infrastructure. Planned facilities of the Mosque and Islamic Center include:

- Prayer facilities for up to 2,250 worshippers
- Full wheelchair access and facilities for persons with special needs
- Art exhibition, library, and interfaith room for dawah
- Office and meeting room
- Separate male and females ablution areas





Based on basic elements and principles of traditional mosque on the prototype developed by our Holy Prophet (PBUH), the proposed mosque has been conceived as landmark and hub of the UMT Campus and surrounding area. A simple, dynamic and traditional-modern architectural blending has been developed with 70 feet multifaceted circular folded dome rising 30 feet above main prayer hall roof top guarded with two minarets of around 100 feet height each opening up in a praying formation with reflection of 'Qalam' (pen) harmonizes with the function of the University. The use of natural elements such as sun, water, vegetation, natural light and intrinsic factors like color, rhythm, harmony in the traditional man made elements of mosque architecture i.e. arches, domes, minarets, courtyards, ablution, jali, calligraphy, tile work, etc. have been fully exploited in the proposed design of the UMT Campus Mosque.
