Saturday 7th Jan 2017

To meet the support needs of enthusiastic researchers/ users at the University of Management and Technology in Lahore, LRC organized a tutorial on Endnote for UMT research scholars in the means of research support services on Thursday 7th January, 2016. The session title was "How to cite and use references in research paper (End Note Training)". **Mr. Nusrat Ali (Library Officer)** was the trainer. He started with the brief introduction and importance of citation and referencing. After that he started training on End note.

EndNote is used by libraries all over the world to teach people about discovering, accessing and evaluating

information in networked computer environments. **Mr. Nusrat Ali** told the students how they can manage their references and import them in their research papers and thesis using End note software. The session was one hour long. The feedback was 100%. These sessions are being appreciated by students as well as faculty members.

The main objectives of this training was to

- * Create, open and close a library (a collection of references).
- * Create a new reference, edit a reference, and search within EndNote for references.

* Find and delete duplicate references.

* Format references and bibliographies to fit different journal styles.

* Import references from databases such as PubMed and Scopus.

* Use connection files within EndNote to search PubMed, PsycINFO, Web of Science, and other databases.

* Use EndNote with Microsoft Word to insert references in a manuscript.



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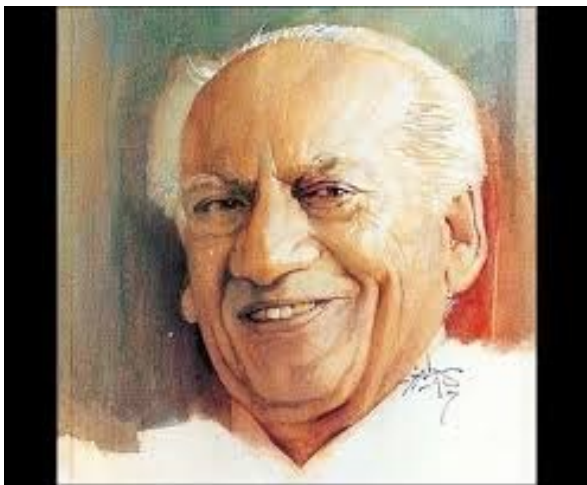

Publishing a research paper in a journal or conference is an important activity within the academic community. LRC session on **“Writing of Research Paper and Process of Publication”** was arranged on Thursday, February 2, 2017 by Rafiq Awan and Tahir Mustafa in 2S-48. Through seminar Chief Library



Officer Muhammad Rafiq Awan and Tahir Mustafa shared their deep insight and in-depth analysis on the subject matter. They also purposefully updated the audience with current and emerging trends in academic publishing. They laid emphasis on the steps involved in the journal publishing cycle.

Further they shared their experiences regarding this seminar, the Pakistani academic writers suffer a lot on account of this deficiency. They are commonly faced with the difficulty of getting published in prestigious journals in the world. They assign the reason of their failure to academic hegemony or imperialism. Whereas the key factor that keeps them at the back step is the lack of their understanding and the skill how to evaluate theirs and others' views and interact with their readership.

Publishing a research paper in a journal or conference is an important activity within the academic community. It allows you to network with other scholars and to further refine your ideas and research. Academic journals are probably the most common place for scholars to publish their research. Find the most suitable academic journal for your topic and writing style so you can tailor your research paper easily and increase its chance of being published.
