HHRD

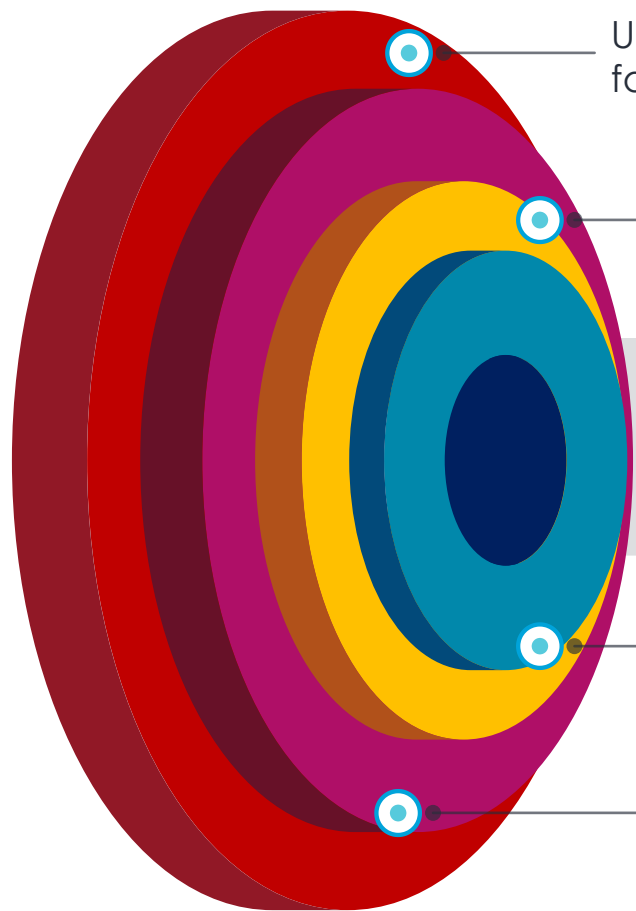

Trees Planted = 22,000 and Counting



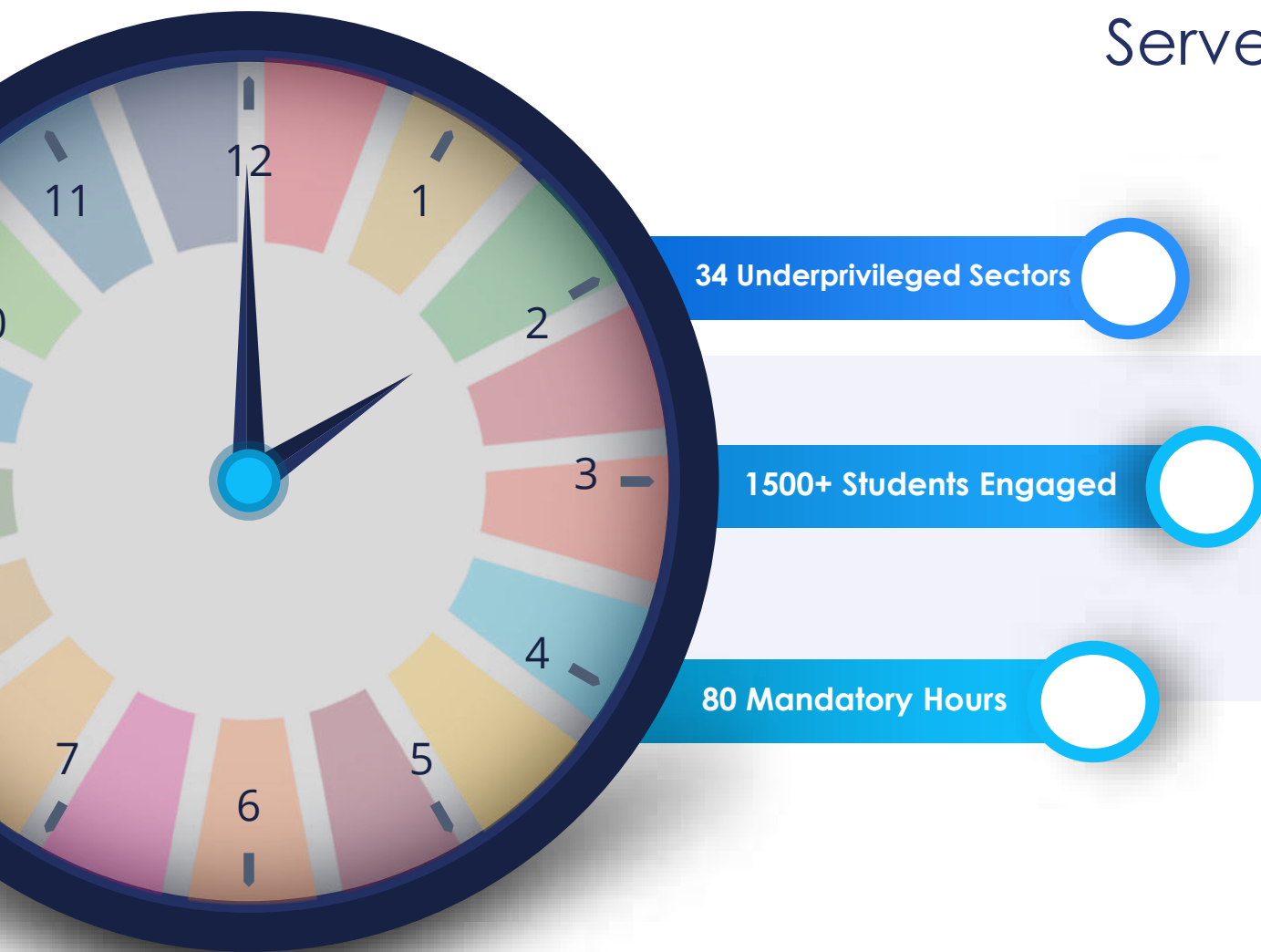
