It featured two international speakers: Dr. M Fahad Humayun from the University of Evansville, Indiana, and Dr. Nagehan Uzuner from Istanbul Bilgi University, Turkey. They both shed light on the vast range of digital avenues in the domain of media and communication. They also mentioned that digital platforms allow diverse voices to be heard. It is important to have an equal access to digital infrastructure for better digital exclusion, they added.

Seven other guests also spoke on the occasion. They included Dr. Farrukh Shehzad from Bahria University, Senior Journalist Mr Intikhab Hanif, Mr. Shiraz Hasnat, Bureau Chief of HUM News, Dr. Mustafa Kamal, Former Station Director at Pakistan Radio, Mr. Muhammad Ikram Barkat, DG PEMRA, Prof. Dr. Faiz Ullah Jan from the University of Peshawar, and Prof. Dr. Bushra H. Rehman from SCS, University of the Punjab. They highlighted the pros and cons of digital media and its effects on society. 
Closing Ceremony-IMCC 2024



SMCS celebrates World Press Freedom Day

The SMCS duly celebrated the World Press Day, and while taking advantage of the occasion, highlighted the environmental crises being faced by Pakistan. It linked the issue with the World Press Freedom Day 2024 through the theme, 'A Press for the Planet: Journalism in the Face of the Environmental Crisis'.

Dean SMCS prof Dr Anjum Zia warmly welcomed the panelists including journalists Mr Saleem Bukhari (Chief Editor/ Director City News Network), Mr Salman Abid (Senior Analyst/ Executive Director IDEA Pakistan), Mr Shiraz Hasnat (Senior Vice President Lahore Press Club) and anchor Mr Imran Sangullah. Mr. Bokhari acknowledged that journalists never paid due attention to the looming threats of climate change and hoped that the new comers to the industry would focus it. Mr Salman Abid seconded Mr Bukhari and highlighted various factors contributing to environmental pollution in Pakistani including unplanned massive urbanization, extensive population growth, heavy infrastructure and reducing agricultural fields. He further emphasized that academia should make climate change a major subject of their curriculum. Mr. Imran Sanaullah said Pakistani media focuses more on the reactionary news than issues like environmental pollution. 
