UMT in Global spotlight:

UMT Strengthens Global Standing in International Rankings 2026

The University of Management and Technology continues to strengthen its global academic reputation through remarkable performance in prestigious international university rankings. These achievements reflect UMT's growing excellence in research, academic quality, sustainability, and global engagement.

In the QS World University Rankings 2026, UMT has been placed in the 1201–1400 band globally, with significant subject-wise recognition in Mathematics (501–600), Economics & Econometrics (551–700), and Computer Science & Information Systems (751–850). At the regional level, the University secured the 351st position in Asia and achieved an impressive 156th rank globally in the International Research Network indicator, highlighting UMT's expanding international research collaborations and academic partnerships. UMT also demonstrated its commitment to sustainable development by securing the 286th position in the QS Sustainability Rankings (Asia) and 860th globally.

Adding to these accomplishments, the Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings 2026 placed UMT in the 801–1000 global band. Notably, UMT earned the distinction of being ranked No. 1 in Research Quality among private-sector universities in Pakistan, reflecting the University's strong research culture and scholarly impact.

UMT's interdisciplinary academic excellence was further acknowledged through its inclusion among the top 184 institutions worldwide in the THE Interdisciplinary Science Rankings. The University also secured a position in the 351–400 band in the THE Asia Rankings 2025 and maintained its standing in the 801–1000 band in the THE Impact Rankings.

In another significant milestone, UMT has been shortlisted for the prestigious THE Awards Asia 2025 in the category of "Leadership and Management Team of the Year," recognizing the University's visionary leadership and institutional excellence.

Organized by the **Khurshid Ahmad Institute of Islamic Economics and Finance (KAIIF)** under the directorship of **Dr. Toseef Azid**, the forum featured Federal Minister for Religious Affairs Sardar Muhammad Yousaf as chief guest, a virtual address by Malaysian Prime Minister Anwar Ibrahim, and participation from the State Bank of Pakistan, SECP, and FPCCI.

The visit featured a panel discussion on "**The Role of CPEC and BRI in Building a Win-Win Future**," where distinguished speakers highlighted the transformative potential of regional connectivity and shared prosperity. The Consul General held strategic talks with UMT Chairman and President, **Ibrahim Hasan Murad**, discussing ways to expand bilateral cooperation in education, technology, and industry.

The seminar highlighted the critical role of women's empowerment in driving community development and sustainable change.

Dr. Hasan Murad School of Management (HSM) Hosted Former Finance Minister Miftah Ismail

The Dr. Hasan Murad School of Management (HSM) hosted former Finance Minister Mr. Miftah Ismail, who delivered a sharp analysis of the economic implications of the Iran-Israel/US conflict on Pakistan. He highlighted severe risks including supply chain disruptions, rising fuel costs, and mounting inflationary pressures on the country's already fragile economy. Ismail noted that Pakistan currently has roughly four weeks of fuel stocks, with plans to extend this to 45 days if needed. He recommended reducing government expenses, lowering taxes on salaried individuals, and addressing inequities in agricultural taxation. The session equipped attendees with critical insights to navigate the evolving economic crisis.



Strengthening Industry-Academia Linkages: UMT Signs MoU with Globe Estate & Builders

The University of Management and Technology, through the **School of Commerce and Accountancy (SCA)** and the **Office of Corporate Linkages and Placements (OCLP)**, signed a **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** with **Globe Estate & Builders**. The collaboration aims to strengthen industry-academia linkages by providing internship and placement opportunities, supporting the **UMT Cooperative Education Program (COOP)**, and facilitating industrial visits, awareness sessions, and mentoring initiatives. The ceremony was attended by representatives from both organizations, including senior leadership and faculty members. This partnership reflects UMT's commitment to enhancing practical learning, employability, and industry engagement.



CIRE Hosted High-Level RERA Roundtable to Strengthen Real Estate Governance

Dr. Fariha Tariq, Dean of the **School of Architecture and Planning (SAP)**, and Director of **Centre for Innovation in Real Estate (CIRE)** at UMT Lahore, convened a high-level **RERA** roundtable to strengthen regulatory governance in Pakistan's real estate sector. The session brought together key stakeholders including **Imran Ali Sultan (Government of Punjab)**, **Ali Awais (AwaisLaw DRT)**, **Mutahir Awan (PCBDDA)**, **Zaigham Mehmood Rizvi (World Bank Consultant)**, **Haroon Hanif (OZ Developers)**, and **Ahsan Nisar (Titanium Agency)**, along with representatives from **PHATA** and **LDA**. Discussions emphasized project registration, consumer protection, professionalization of agents, and digital governance. The dialogue contributed actionable policy directions for a more transparent and sustainable real estate regulatory framework, reflecting UMT's commitment to bridging academia, industry, and government.



Students attended Seminar on Strait of Hormuz Crisis and Global Trade Disruptions



Office of Participant Affairs (OPA) hosted a special seminar titled "Navigating the Crisis: How the Strait of Hormuz Closure is Reshaping Global Trade". A renowned columnist and analyst **Orya Maqbool Jan** was also one of the experts invited for this seminar. The session analyzed severe geopolitical and economic consequences of the ongoing blockade, which has disrupted 20% of global crude oil transit. Brent crude has exceeded \$90 per barrel, driving global inflationary pressures worldwide. Experts examined shifting trade routes, increased pressure on alternative ports like Jeddah, and Pakistan's strategic positioning. The seminar provided critical insights into structural changes in global energy supply chains and the potential for long-term recession if maritime restrictions remain.

Reviving Khudi: UMT Session Explores Allama Iqbal's Vision for Youth Empowerment

Sitara-o-Hilal Foundation organized an engaging session featuring **Mr. Muneeb Iqbal**, grandson of **Dr. Allama Muhammad Iqbal**. The speaker highlighted the enduring relevance of **Allama Iqbal's** philosophy in contemporary times, with a particular focus on the concept of **Khudi** (selfhood and self-reliance). Students were encouraged to adopt Iqbal's vision of self-awareness, confidence, and inner strength to effectively navigate modern-day challenges. The session also shed light on Iqbal's correspondence with **Quaid-e-Azam Muhammad Ali Jinnah**, illustrating how Islamic principles can be thoughtfully adapted to meet evolving societal needs. Participants appreciated the insightful discussion, recognizing the session as a meaningful contribution toward fostering intellectual growth, moral development, and character building among youth through the timeless wisdom of Pakistan's national poet.
