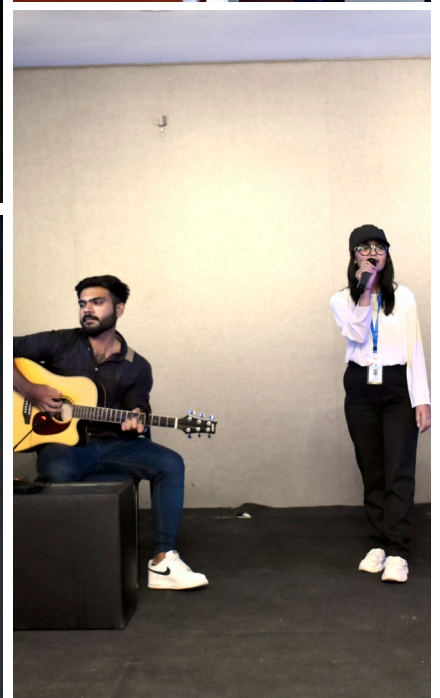
# Workshop on Outcomes Based Education Arranged for Deans and Directors

## OPA Arranges Delightful Literary Eve

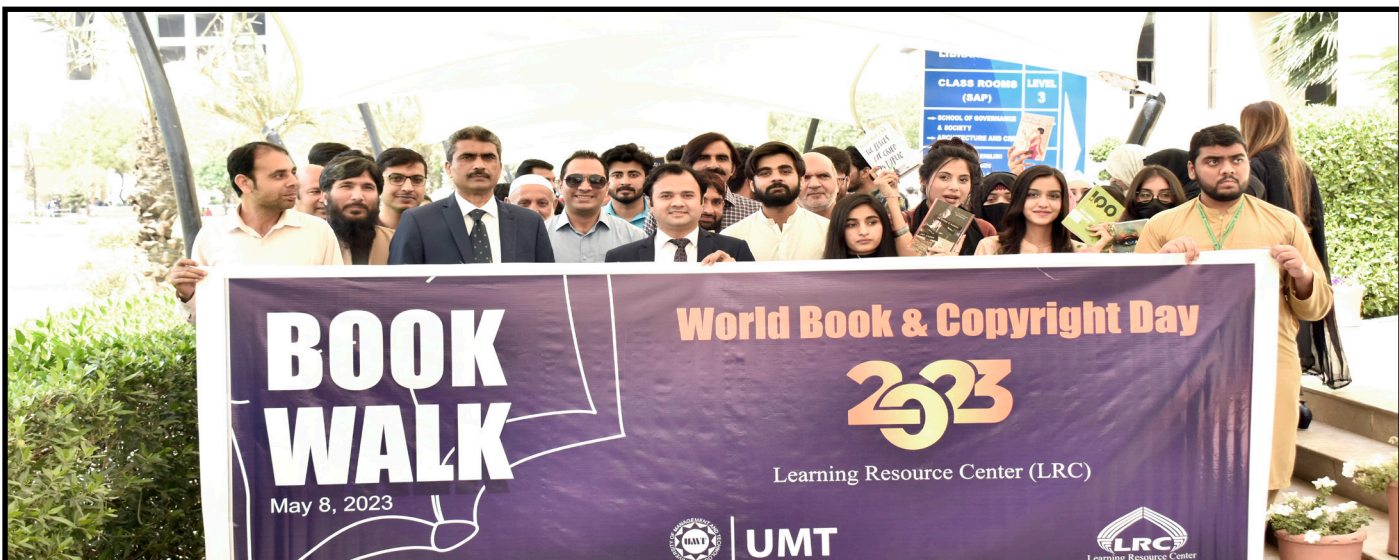
