Meeting Objectives

This meeting aimed to bring all stakeholders of AMDIP on one platform to discuss the opportunities and future road map, and to review the past performance. It was intended to develop policies and strategies in accordance with the modern facet of management and business education. Local chapter chairpersons, and representatives from member institutions were requested to share their insight about the challenges that management education is dealing with, in the region. It was expected that this meeting will open new avenues for AMDIP to strive for excellence in management education and practices.

Meeting Proceedings:

Dr. Shahid Amjad Chaudhry, Chairperson AMDIP Chaired the meeting and started with his welcome remarks. Ms. Memoona Zareen, Secretary AMDIP Convened the meeting.

I. Review of AMDIP Activities 2017-18

Ms. Memoona Zareen gave a brief review of the activities organized or partnered by AMDIP in the year 2017-18. The 2nd IoBM-AMDIP Faculty Colloquium, and the 2nd International Conference on Experiential Learning both hosted by IOBM, Karachi. The 2nd Conference on Business, Economics and Education Management (ICBEM) planned to be organized by IBA-Sukkur, 7Th International Conference on Business and Management (ICOBM) planned to be organized by IMSciences Peshawar and 3rd International SME Conference jointly hosted by UMT, SMEDA and AMDIP. Dr. Shahid Amjad Chaudhry appreciated all business schools who hosted AMDIP events. Later on agenda for new initiatives was discussed by Chairperson and other board members.

II. Decisions made for AMDIP Activities for the year 2018-19 based on discussion

- i. All AMDIP Chapter Chairpersons would organize a '<u>Teaching and Learning Conference</u>' at regional level in which they will invite other business schools to discuss on going practices as well as innovation in teaching methodology, pedagogy, course contents and outlines. This conference will have a clear focus on faculty and teaching practices. In Lahore this conference would be organized by Lahore School of Economics.
- ii. A conference on **Experiential Learning and Cases Writing** would be organized jointly by LUMS and AMDIP. The conference will be taken care by LUMS under the supervision of Dr. Syed Zahoor Hassan.
- iii. <u>Centralized Cases Repository</u> would be developed by AMDIP that will comprise on cases written on local industry. For this repository cases would be shared by AMDIP

member business schools. Additionally, it was recommended that universities should try to bring MBA projects and MS thesis done by their students on their websites.

iv. A <u>Business Programs Directory</u> would be developed by AMDIP of specialized business programs being taught in Pakistani Universities. It will contain the information of each program including roadmap, courses, contents, outlines and teaching materials.

III. Next Board Meeting

Next Board Meeting of AMDIP will be held with 6th Dean and Directors Conference by NBEAC and 15th South Asian Management Forum by AMDISA in the month of March, 2019 at Lahore.
