

BS Economics – Post ADP Roadmap

Eligibility Criteria

14-years of formal education (ADP) with minimum 50% marks or 2:00 GPA

Duration: 2.5 years including Bridging Semester

Semesters: 5

Credit Hours: 66-72

Students after 2-years of ADP degree would be enrolled in Bridging Semester of minimum 9 and maximum 15 credit hours for deficiency courses. The selection of courses for bridging semester may vary from case to case depending upon the courses completed in 2-years of ADP Program and HEC approved structure of BS Economics Program. From Semesters 5 to 8, there are total 57 credit hours in the road map of BS Economics. Through this scheme, students will undertake total 72 Credit Hours to earn a BS Economics Degree from UMT.

Fee Calculation of BS (ECO)-Post ADP Degree

Per Credit Hour Fee = PKR 10,809.17

Minimum Tuition fee:

Tuition fee with 66 Credit Hrs = PKR 10809.17 x 66 = PKR 713,405.22 approx

Maximum Tuition Fee:

Tuition fee with 72 Credit Hrs = PKR 10,809.17 x 72 = PKR 778,260.24 approx

- Admission and library fee PKR 25000/- is non-refundable/non-transferable and will be charged with 1st installment.
