


Figure 2: Acceptance Rate in UMT Journals

Figure 4: Number of Authors by Geography



Figure 5: 30 Days Average and Record Visitors on UMT Journal's Website



Figure 7: Citation of UMT Journals by Year





Figure 8: Detailed Citation of UMT Journals by Year
