

•20% tuition fee waiver

3.10 Women Institute of Learning and Leadership (WILL) Scholarship

35% scholarship is offered to female students of BBA and MBA to promote learning and leadership opportunities for women in the field of business.

3.11 Digital Pakistan Scholarship

- 2. Please wait for your turn for information/counseling/admission form issuance
- 3. Admission forms should be submitted in the form receiving section and an admit card is to be received
- 4. Fee is to be submitted in mentioned Bank as per voucher issued to you.
- 5. After banking hours, the fee could be deposited in Accounts Office
- 6. Students are encouraged to apply in two or more programs for which no additional fee would be charged
- 7. Discounted vouchers (Alumni, Kinship, Merit Scholarship, Quota Scholarships, etc.) are to be issued from Registrar Office (After submission of scholarship form and relevant documents)
- 8. Copy of paid fee voucher is to be submitted in Registrar Office for issuance of student ID

Important Instructions

- 1. Admission fee of Rs. 25000/- will be charged with first fee installment
- 2. The cost of one admission form is Rs.1500/-
- 3. The cost of one alumni form is Rs. 500/-, the photocopy of alumni card is to be submitted for issuance of admission form
- 4. Admission form once bought is non refundable/non transferable
- 5. For Engineering program, the fee would be charged per semester (6 months basis)
