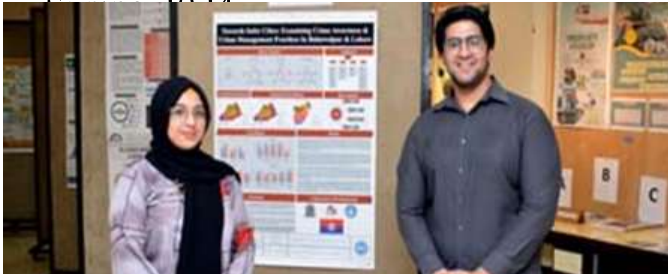

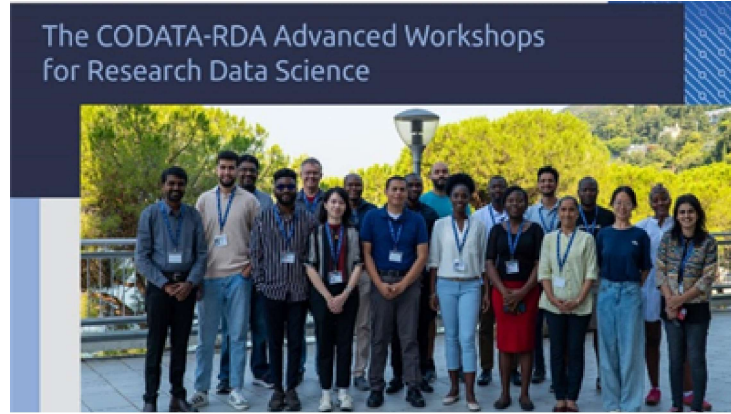
Participation of Batch-08 Participant, Muhammad Junaid in International Circular Cities Course at University of Amsterdam: (Summer 2024)

Field Visit of High-Rise Buildings by the Participants of Batch-09 and Batch-11: (November 27, 2024)

The students from Batch 9 (3rd Year) and Batch 11 (1st Year) of BS CRP visited several ongoing construction projects in Gulberg, Lahore, focusing on corporate offices and skyscrapers. The first site visited was the Al Fatah Tower, a 21-floor building with a height of 285 feet. The construction is in progress, with the grey structure 60-70% complete. Secondly, the students visited the Sabroso Corporate Tower, a 12-floor structure standing 135 meters tall. Its grey structure was completed, and the project has moved to the finishing phase. The final site was Burjh One, the tallest skyscraper under construction to date, comprising 24 floors. Throughout the visit, students gained valuable knowledge about large-scale construction processes, building bylaws set by relevant authorities, and the practical challenges of urban development.
