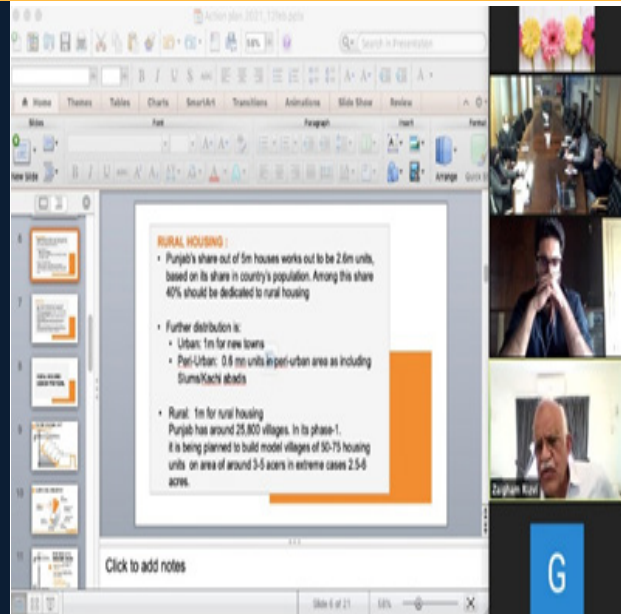
International Consultant- Dar ul Hindusa visited CRP Department for Stakeholder Consultation on Master plan of Lahore:
