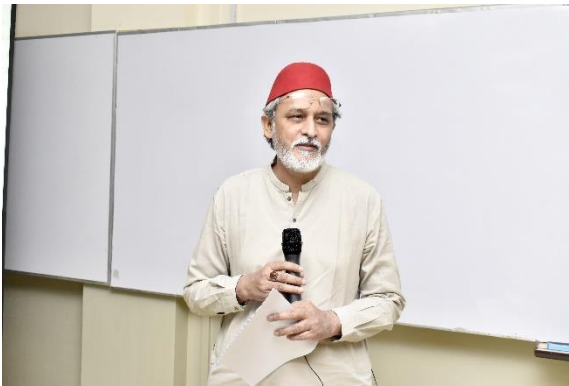

MODEL MAKING Workshop - Thinking Through Making 2-Feb-22

The first-year design studio represented the first encounter between prospective architects and architectural design. This specific assignment aimed at introducing physical modelling as a technique and method of design communication.

Students were given the choice of collecting and filling their design inventory with all sorts of waste materials and using them as building blocks for their physical models. The task was to explore different shapes, materials and even textures to create an abstract physical model. Another requirement of this exercise was to fix a light source and cast a shadow in space (of their interest) and develop a familiar figure or setting. The entire task revolves around the idea of “Thinking through Making”; where students learn how effective model making can be as a tool for research and design.



International Symposium on Architecture and Planning: (March 31, 2022)

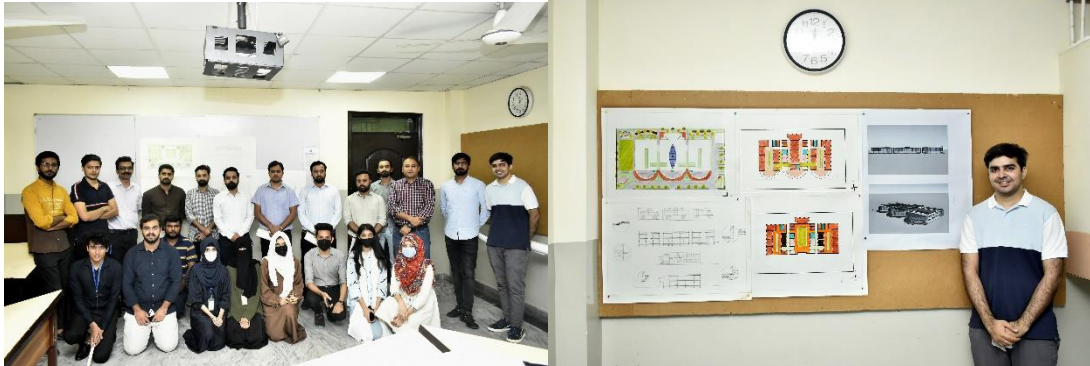
10th Graduate Seminar - 16-June-22

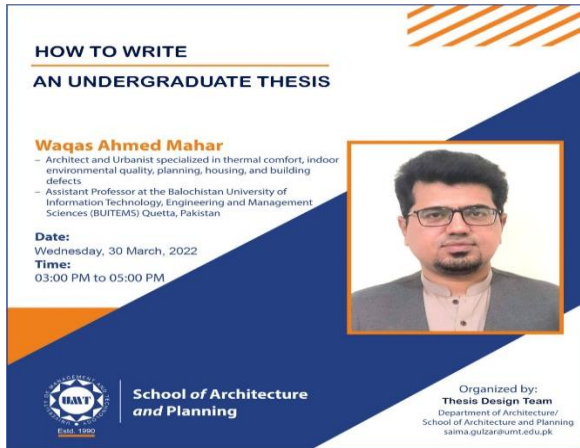

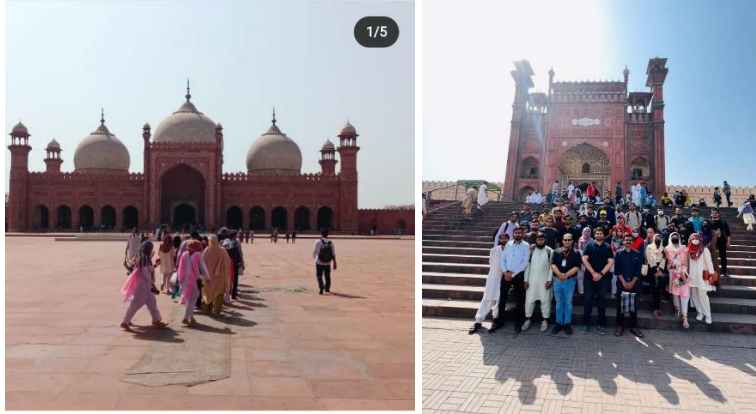
The student of Batch-09 of Bachelor of Architecture visited the historical place Hiran Minar to explore the Mughal Landscape.

It involved visit the "Abu Yusuf Showroom, Ferozepur road" to explore the flooring materials, wall tiles, kitchen fixtures and appliances.

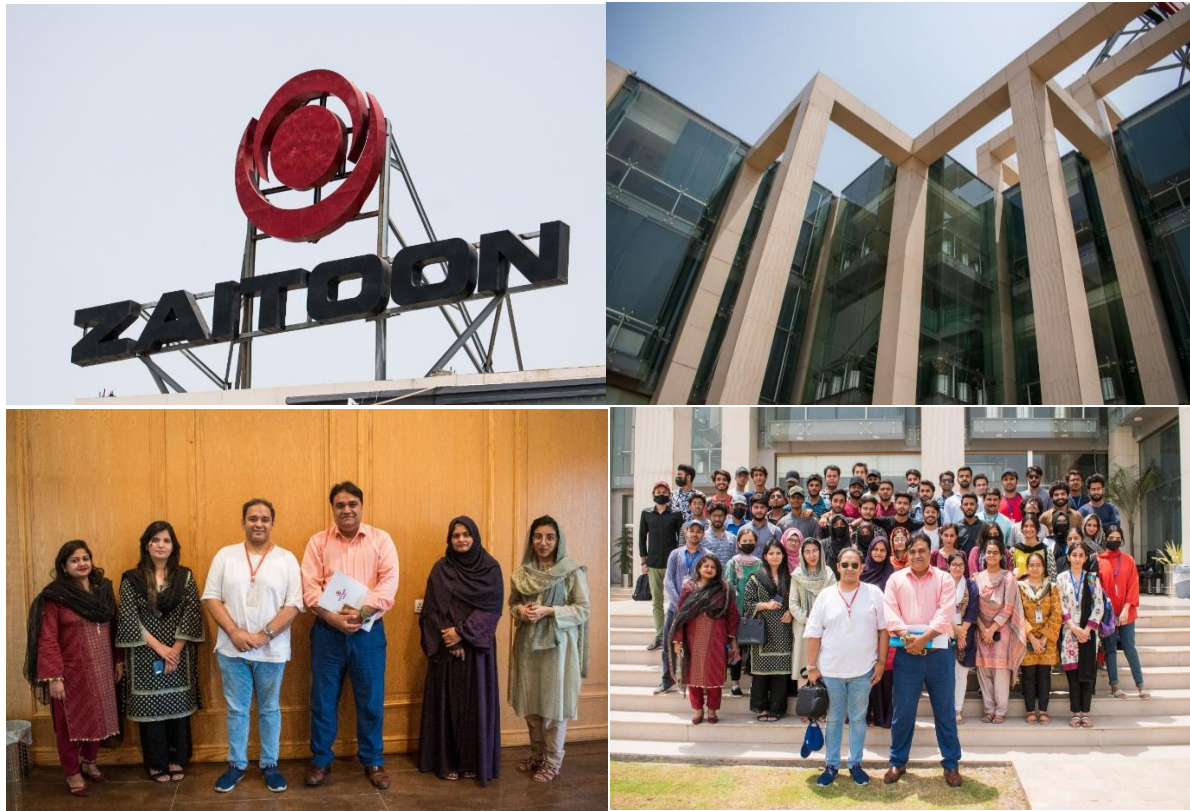


Study trip to Zaitoon City

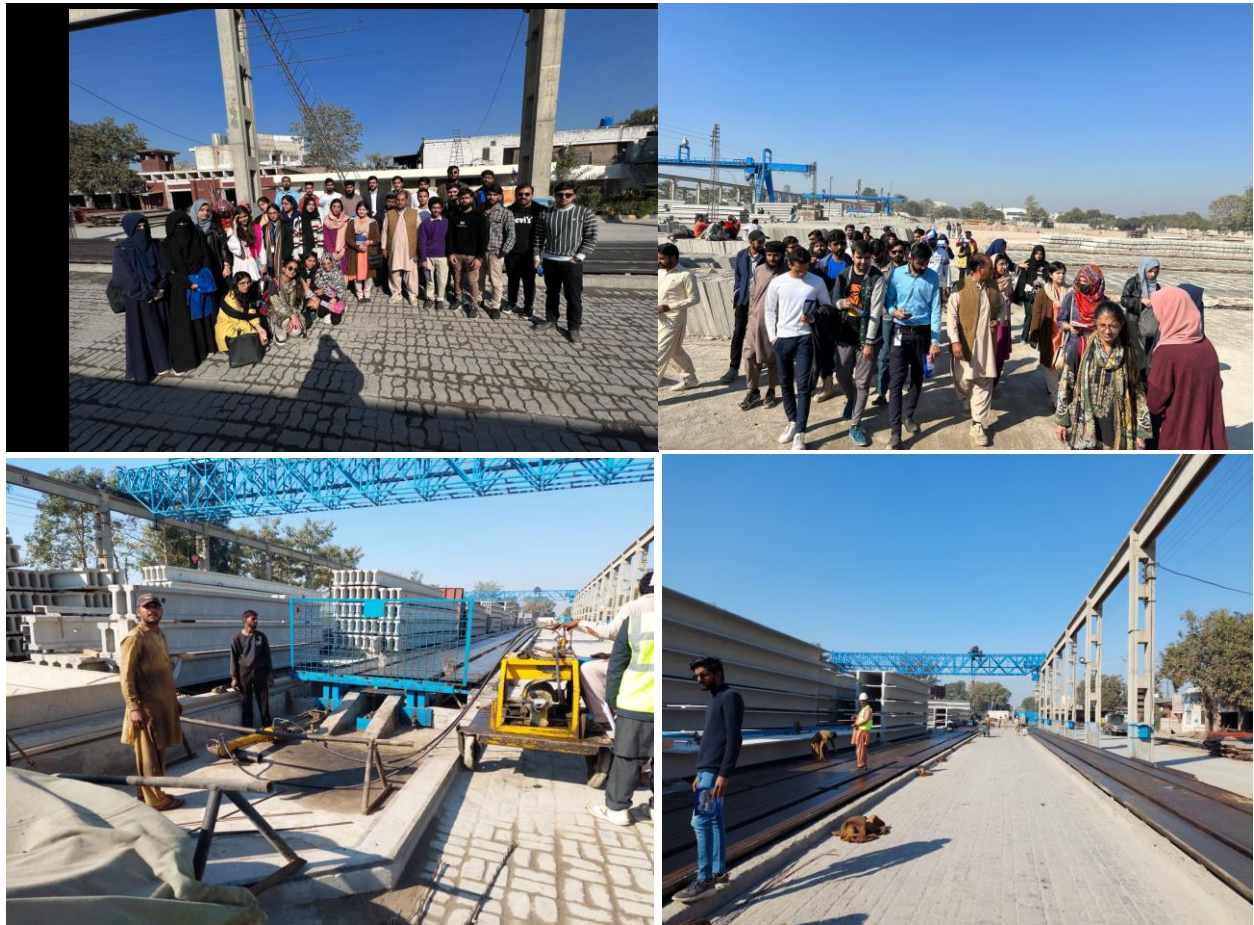
Purpose of visit: The students did a complete site visit. The site supervisor explained all details regarding the project being constructed. The time was given to the students to document the site and note down important points.
