Roundtable Discussion on National Security Policy



The School of Governance and Society (SGS) arranged a roundtable discussion on the 'National Security Policy'. The keynote speakers who participated in this academic engagement were Prof Naveed Elahi (Moderator), Dr Rabia Akhter Director Centre for Security, Strategy and Policy Research, University of Lahore, Khawaja Khalid Faroog, PSP - Former IGP, Dr Seemi Waheed, Sarmad Saeed Khan, PSP - Former IGP, Prof Rahat-ul-Ain, Abid Sherwani, DG and Cofounder UMT, Lt General (Retd) Ghulam Mustafa, Security Analyst and Mujeeb-ur-Rehman Shami, Chief Editor Daily Pakistan. The learned participants talked about various contours, contents and dimensions of the policy. In the opening lines, Prof Naveed Elahi pointed out that the previous National Internal Security Policy 2018-23 was not consulted while formulating the NSP. Dr Rabia was of the view that NSP was a step in the right direction and was guite comprehensive. Former IGP Khalid Faroog considered it a disjointed document that lacked cohesion. Mujib ur Rehman Shami seconded this opinion and termed it more of a loose compilation of various existing ideas. Gen Mustafa appreciated the NSA, Dr Moeed and his team for producing a good policy. Sarmad Saeed Khan, former IGP, stated that there was always room for improvement and this document could be further improved with the passage of time. SGS has generated a report on this roundtable which is available on the SGS website. (January 20, 2022)

Visit and Briefing of Delegation of National Prisons Academy



A delegation of the National Prisons Academy, comprising the instructors and trainees, visited the School of Governance and Society and enlightened the students of BS Public Administration about "Prison's Administration & Rehabilitation of Prisoners". They elaborated on the role of prisons in the criminal justice system, governing laws for prisons, classification of prisons and prisoners, arrangements for juveniles in Punjab, diet and



clothing of prisoners as per PPR - 1978, and initiatives of the government for the rehabilitation of prisoners. The students asked interesting and relevant questions to the delegation. In the end, Prof Naveed Elahi summed up the discussion, thanked the DG National Prisons Academy, Mr Azhar Rasheed, PSP, for arranging this visit and presented shields to the delegation.
