
In 2015, GALLERY 6 introduced the biennial "Arjumand Painting Award" to recognize outstanding emerging Pakistani painters 25-40 years of age. "Onrushing-4" is the fourth group show of the outstanding participants of this national contest. This exhibition includes 4 prize winners also.



Abid Aslam studied at the Hunerkada College, Lahore, then acquired Masters in Visual Arts from National College of Arts in 2017. His current artworks are made by mixing two traditional art practices, miniature and metal engraving (as done on objects). He engraves on wasli with tools ranging from different sizes and shapes, which gives the 3D and 2D effect to the surface. The work revolves around the patterns, which on the whole creates imagery when seen from a distance. The delicate intricate patterns adds to the meaning of created imagery. It becomes very interesting to see that how two different traditions can directly lay in conversation with each other and what narrative they produce at the end for the viewer.

Besides Pakistan, she has exhibited works in Dubai, New York, Oman and Toronto. In her paintings, she makes a conscious attempt to present resemblance between nature and human interactions in a poetic interpretation. She has been inspired by bougainvillea plants as it fascinates her that how they turn some of their leaves pink or white to attract more insects for pollination process. She feels that in some way we all are some sorts of bougainvillea who are trying to turn their flaws into flowers so that more and more people can love us, admire us and accept us.

Amna Manzoor graduated from National College of Arts in 2013 and then acquired Masters in Graphic Design from University of Management & Technology, Lahore, in 2018, where she is a faculty member. She won Merit Prize and Second Prize in Arjumand Painting Award in 2015 and 2017. Her work is about the conditioning that happens in life under harsh social milieu, which often leaves a permanent mark on the personality. In her paintings, the threads show entangling of a person in the thorns of unexpected environment, flowers with thorns represent pleasure with pain, while silk threads reflects the delicate yet strong love that requires sacrifice, as for the love to endure, silk worms eventually die. Her artwork advocates to love the imperfections and the incompleteness that leave several marks in our lives and cherish them as precious scars, which could make one feel stronger and wiser.






Artist: Amna Manzoor Title: The new emergence II Gouache on wasli, size 13 x 10 inches Price Rs. 75,000





Muhammad Sulaman graduated in 2015 and did Masters in Visual Arts in 2019 from National College of Arts, Lahore. He has exhibited his work in Pakistan, Italy and China. His artwork focuses on clothes with multiple meanings. Clothes reflect who the person is i.e. his social identity and status, hence there are studies of class consciousness that revolves around the creation of a self-image and the influences that shape it. Secondly, one observes artworks directed towards the west influenced branding that plays a significant role in setting social placement. Thirdly, there is a discourse on clothes for their role in privacy by which one decides to show or hide some parts/angles of one's identity and what dictates an individual to select what to show, where to show and how to show.

Abdul Aziz Meer initially did BSc in Physics and Mathematics but moved on to pursue art and graduated from National College of Arts in 2017 with focus in miniature. He see his work as an extension of his being. He calls himself a modern day print-maker, as he uses his body as a plate and smoke as ink and then etch himself by rolling on to the paper to make unique large scale monotypes. His artworks have distorted figures as if they are fossilized human forms. Using his miniature skills, he adds depth and visual intricacies to the artwork through the traditional techniques of Siah Qalam and Neem Rang.

Nadia adds layer over layers, which generates depth and gives 3 dimensional impact to the painting. The process of the work is enjoyable and exciting for her because she does not only paint the houses but builds them too.






Artist: Nadia Batool Title: Untitled Mix media on wasli, size 17 x 12 inches Price Rs. 67,000








Artist: Asghar Ali Title: Untitled Gouache on paper, size 16 x 23 inches Price Rs. 100,000






Artist: Tauqeer Baig Title: Red Turban Mix media on canvas, size 36 x 45 inches Price Rs. 185,000




Artist: Tauqeer Baig Title: Orange Turban Mix media on canvas, size 36 x 48 inches Price Rs. 135,000
